- 1) **Select** <u>Tracc Civil Pty Ltd</u> as the preferred Tenderer for the *Contaminated Material Remediation and Bulk Earthworks for the Lloyd Street Extension in Midland RFT19DF41* for the lump sum price of one million, one hundred and forty five thousand, one hundred and eighty three dollars and forty eight cents (\$1,145,183.48) excluding GST;
- 2) Accept the provisional sum for the remediation works of the contaminated waste fill from lot 315, including utility corridors and drainage trenches, for the estimated price of ninety three thousand, two hundred and fifty four dollars and seventy cents (\$93,254.70) excluding GST; and
- 3) Advise all Tenderers accordingly.
