Your personal information

The City of Swan (the City) collects personal information about individuals for a range of purposes to enable it to carry out its functions. The City's Privacy Policy is available on its website at www.swan.wa.gov.au/privacy.

Further details about the collection of your personal information are provided below.

Come and Try Sessions Application Form – Privacy Collection Notice	
Who is collecting your personal information	Your personal information is being collected by the City of Swan. The City's Privacy Policy contains information about how you may contact the City.
Collection of your personal information	The City collects your personal information, including your name, contact details and relevant information about the child applicant.
Why your personal information is being collected	Your personal information is collected for the purpose of registering attendance at come and try sessions, administering participation in those sessions, communicating with you about the sessions, and facilitating the child's introduction to the relevant sporting club. Providing the requested information is necessary for the City to register and manage attendance. If you do not provide the requested information, your child may be unable to attend the come and try sessions.
Who will your personal information be disclosed to?	The City will disclose relevant personal information to the sporting club associated with the come and try session so that it can administer participation, communicate with you regarding the session, and contact you about future participation opportunities. The City may also disclose your personal information to other parties where required or authorised by law.
Access to and correction of your personal information	The City's Privacy Policy contains information about how you may access or seek correction of your personal information that is held by the City.
Privacy complaints	The City's Privacy Policy contains information about how you may complain about a breach of the Information Privacy Principles and how the City will deal with complaints.
