Food business consists solely of selling food that is not potentially hazardous food and is contained in a closed package so that it cannot be handled in the course of conducting the food business e.g. lolly counter at a chemist or newsagent.

Food business consists solely of providing complimentary drinks in conjunction with another business conducted at those premises.

Important Information

An exempted food business is exempted from registration only. They are still required to comply with the remaining requirements of the *Food Act 2008* and *Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code*. In particular food handlers should have sufficient skills and knowledge to ensure only safe and suitable food is provided. Adequate measures should be taken to ensure the premises and all equipment is maintained in a clean and hygienic condition and food is protected from contamination. Food must also comply with the labelling requirements of the *Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code*. Food businesses operating as stalls at events must also comply with the City's *Consolidated Local Laws 2005*. A separate trading in public places application may also be required.
