Pensioner Concession

To be eligible for a 50% concession, pensioners must produce one of the following:

1. Pensioner Concession Card;
2. Veteran Affairs Card;
3. Commonwealth Seniors Health Card together with a Seniors Card; **and**
4. State Concession Card

If you are mailing your application, please include a photocopy of the relevant card (showing both front and back of the card).

Sterilisation

A cat is exempt from sterilisation if:

- a. A certificate is given by a veterinarian stating that to sterilise the cat may adversely affect the health and welfare of the cat;
- b. The cat is owned by an approved breeder for the purpose of breeding, and
- c. The cat belongs to a class of cats prescribed as exempt of sterilisation

Microchipping

All cats aged six months and over **must** be microchipped and details must be provided at time of registration.

A cat may be exempt from microchipping if a certificate is given by a veterinarian stating that the implantation of a microchip in the cat may adversely affect the health and welfare of the cat.

Exemptions

Registration exemptions apply for cats in care with SAFE (Saving Animals from Euthanasia) for a total of not more than 12 weeks.

Exemptions apply to the following entities:

- SAFE Incorporated, which includes the branches of Albany, Bunbury, Carnarvon, Esperance, Karratha, Broome, Newman, Goldfields and Metro;
- SAFE Port Hedland; and
- SAFE Busselton

The exemption does not apply to Saving Perth Animals from Euthanasia which is operating as a separate identity.

Previous registration certificates are not acceptable as proof of sterilisation.
