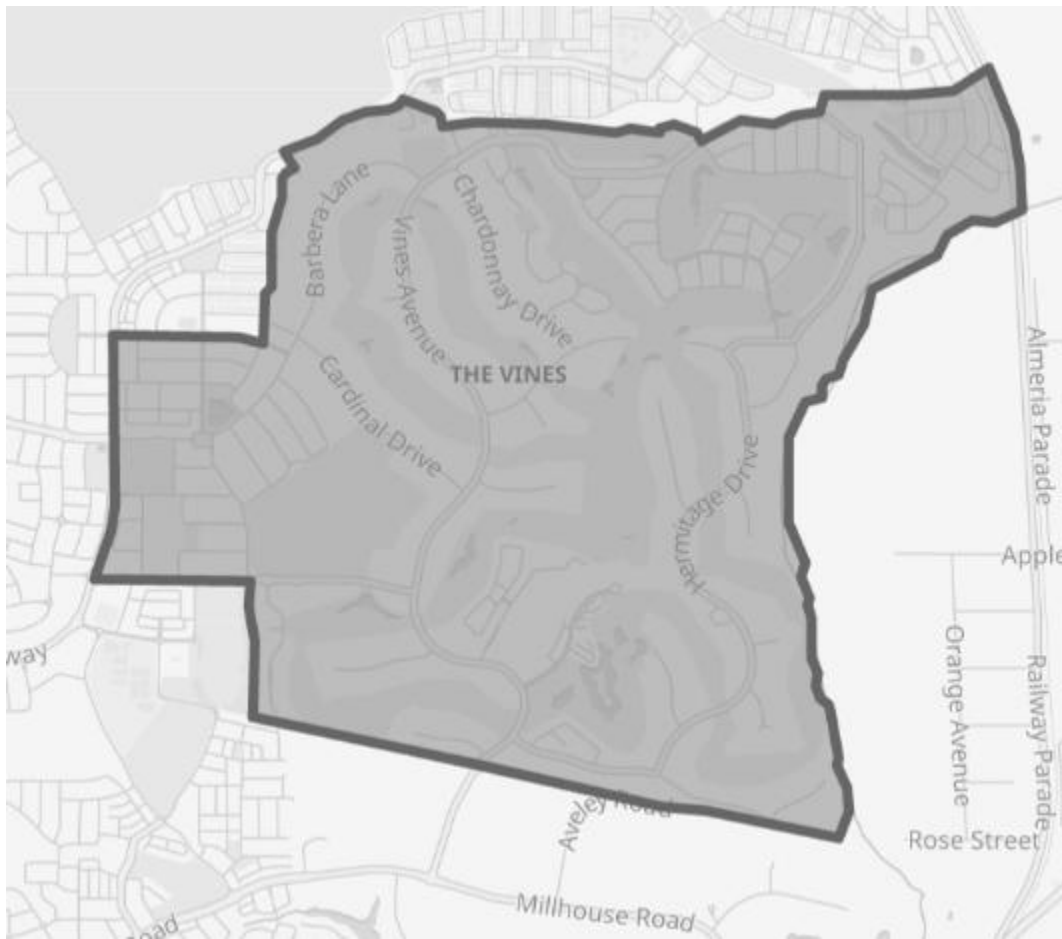




The Vines
Community Security Patrols
May 2026



Overview

Major Security Services has been engaged to provide 24-hour, seven-day Community Security Patrol services for properties located within The Vines. Patrols are conducted throughout all streets within the suburb to maintain a visible security presence and assist in promoting community safety.

While patrols follow a structured coverage of the area, they are also undertaken at random and varied intervals to ensure patrol patterns remain unpredictable for security purposes.

Residents can contact the Community Security Patrol on **(08) 9278 9696** to report matters such as disorderly conduct, suspicious behaviour, loitering, burglary, anti-social behaviour, graffiti, maintenance hazards, or potential breaches of local laws.

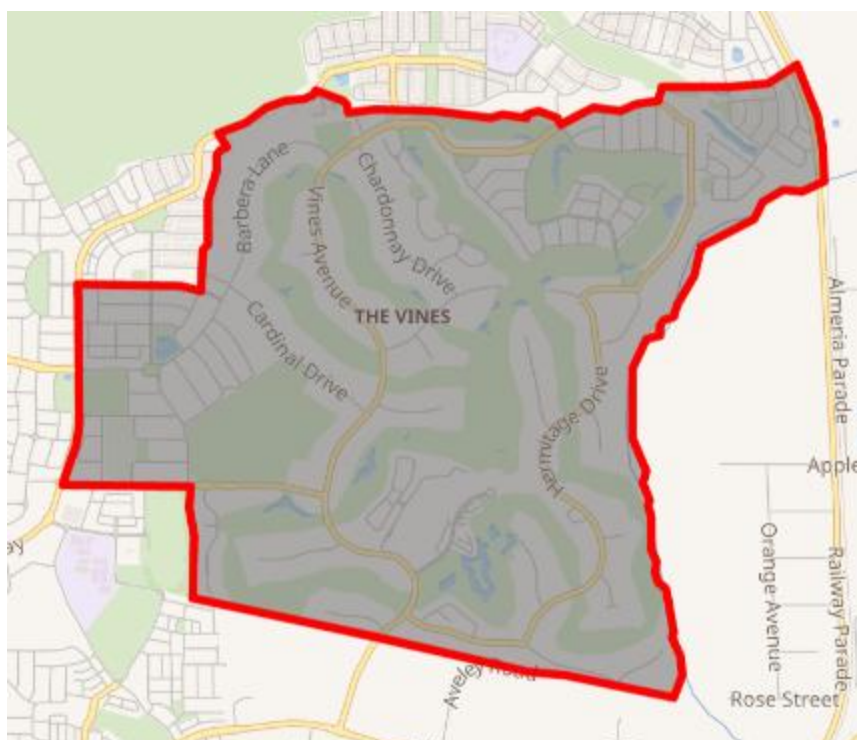

Community Engagement and Response Times

During May 2026, Major Security patrol officers recorded **324 interactions** with residents within The Vines community. Of these, **fourteen (14)** interactions were direct responses to requests for assistance from residents.

Major Security is pleased to report that the response time to all resident calls for assistance was **under 10 minutes**.

Damage

There were **two (2)** damages incident reported in the month of May 2026. Details for one of the incidents have been forwarded to City of Swan for their attention.

On 31/5/2026 at 1350hrs, S/O Jayden contacted the City of Swan to report a fallen tree blocking half of the roadway in front of 7 Hermitage Drive. The report was lodged with Customer Service Officer: Lexy, under Job Number: 1104360.



Graffiti

Anti-social Behaviour

Four (4) incidents relating to anti-social behaviour in the month of May 2026. Detail of these incidents have been forwarded to City of Swan for their attention.

Anti-social behaviour can include:

- threats intimidation, offensive behaviour or assault

- noise or disturbances arising from domestic disputes

Suspicious Activities

Four (4) incidents relating to suspicious activities are recorded in the month of May 2026. Detail of these incidents have been forwarded to City of Swan for their attention.

Major Security maintains records of all reported suspicious activities and has increased patrol frequency in the relevant areas as a precautionary measure. These observations have also been reported to **Crime Stoppers WA** to support broader community safety efforts within The Vines.

Surveillance Patrols

Major Security conducted 0 specific property checks during May 2026.

Residents who plan to be away from their property for an extended period are encouraged to contact the patrol service. Security officers can include additional visual checks of the property during routine community patrols, provided all doors and windows are properly secured prior to departure.

Animals

Four (4) incidents relating to animals were reported during May 2026.

On 1/6/2026, S/O Jayden contacted the City of Swan to report two dead kangaroos at separate locations:

- In front of 53 Barbera Lane — Job Number: 1096159
- Across the road from 29 Hermitage Drive — Job Number: 1096160

Both reports were lodged with Customer Service Agent: Brandon.

On 5/5/2026, S/O Jawad observed a dead chicken lying in the middle of the roadway near 130 Hermitage Drive during patrol. S/O removed the animal from the roadway to prevent obstruction or hazard. The matter will be reported to the City of Swan, and the next guard was informed during the morning handover. Day Guard reported incident to City of Swan the following day (Job Number 1097501)

On 26/5/2026 at 1330hrs, S/O Lutfur observed a dead kangaroo near 26 Cardinal Drive while conducting patrol duties at approximately 1400hrs. S/O contacted the City of Swan, who acknowledged the report and advised that they would arrange removal of the animal. (Report no. 1103197)



Details of the fourth incident have been forwarded to City of Swan for their attention.

Miscellaneous

Nil (0) incidents were recorded during May 2026.

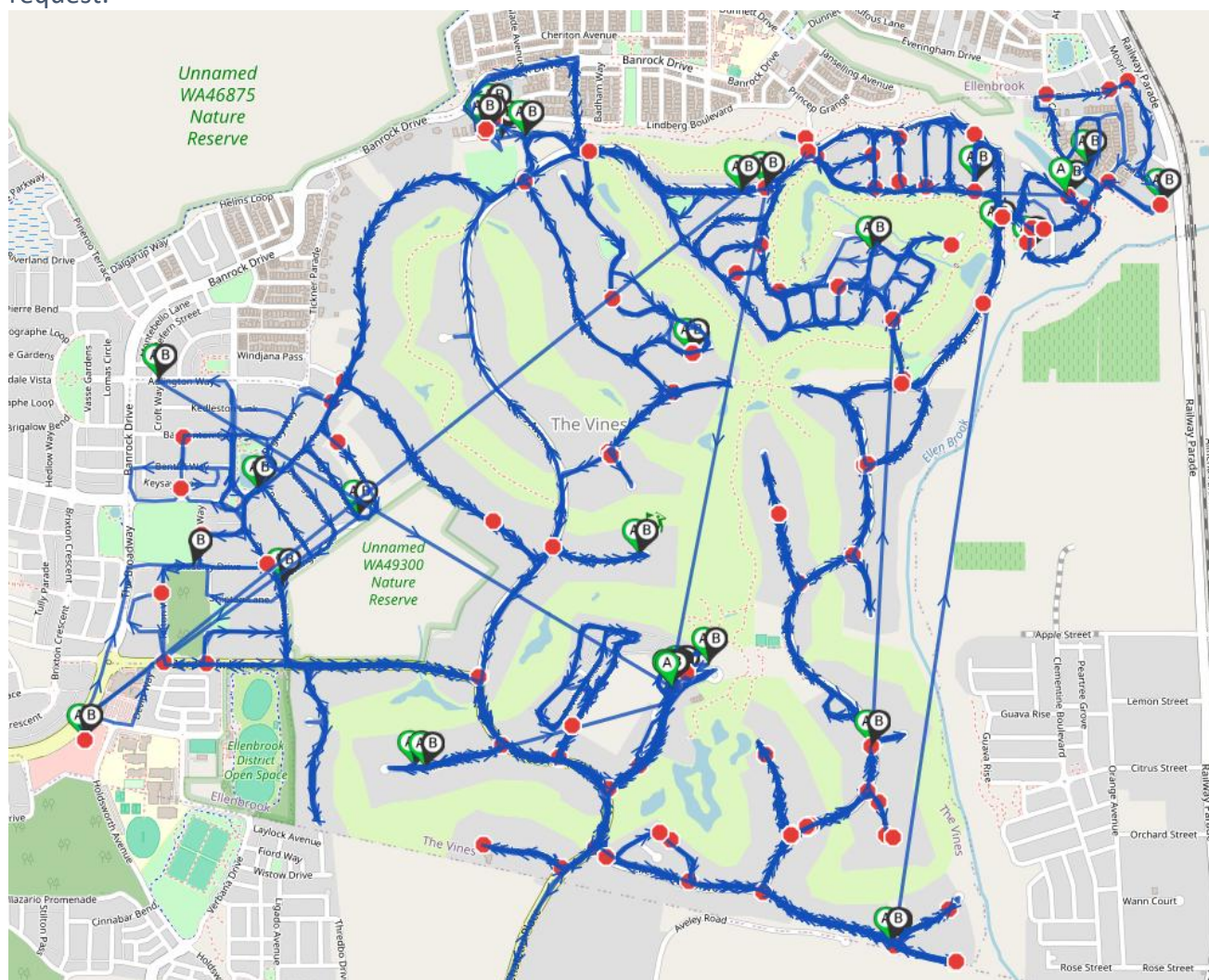
Patrol Monitoring and GPS Tracking

Major Security patrol vehicles are equipped with GPS tracking systems, which allow us to monitor the real-time location of patrol vehicles and capture operational data such as vehicle movement and speed at any given time.

The GPS system enables Major Security to verify patrol coverage throughout The Vines and ensures accountability in the delivery of the Community Security Patrol service.

Below is a sample overview of patrol activity conducted on 5 May 2026. Detailed location data of the patrol vehicle is recorded within the tracking system.

For security and operational reasons, the full GPS tracking reports are not published publicly. However, Major Security will provide copies of the GPS patrol reports to the City of Swan upon request.



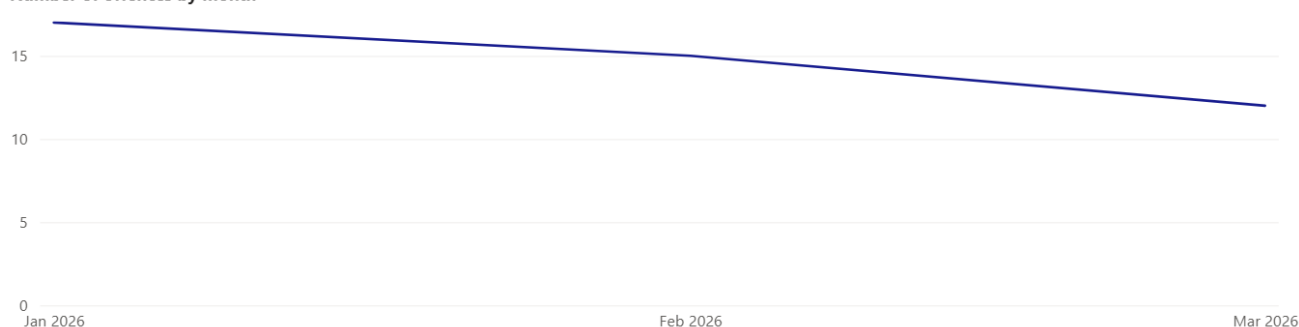
Crime Statistics
