## **Community Security Patrols**

April 2023





#### **Overview**

Major Security Services has been contracted to conduct Community Security Patrol services twentyfour (24) hours/ seven (7) days a week to all properties situated within The Vines area. In addition to structured patrolling of all streets, patrols were undertaken in a random manner and were not easily predictable for security reasons.

The contact number for the security patrol is **(08) 9278 9696**. We encourage residents to report any issues to security such as disorderly conduct, loitering, burglary, anti-social behaviour, graffiti, maintenance hazards or breaches of local laws.

Please note, if residents are personally concerned about a developing situation, WA Police should always be the first port of call. If residents require local police assistance call **131 444**, or for life threatening situations call **000**.

#### Anti-social Behaviour

- trespass
- noise and disturbance from domestic arguments

#### Vehicle issues

There were **two (2) incidents** relating to vehicle issues. Details of these incidents have been forwarded to City of Swan for their attention.

Issues that are listed in this category include:

- Suspicious vehicle parked at a location for a lengthy period of time
- Hooning (Burnouts) activities

#### **Suspicious Activities**

There were **six (6) incidents** relating to suspicious activities. Details of these incidents have been forwarded to City of Swan for their attention.

Major Security has been taking notes on each suspicious activities that was reported and has increased patrols frequency in the reported areas. In addition to the patrols, we have also reported these suspicious activities to Crime Stoppers WA to make The Vines community safer.

#### Surveillance Patrols

Major Security Services have conducted **653** property checks. We encourage residents to contact us if they are going away on holidays and ensure all windows and doors are locked and secure. Our security officers can conduct patrols surrounding your property as part of our community patrols.

#### <u>Animals</u>

0 incident relating to animals were reported in the month of April 2023. One of the incident's details have been forwarded to City of Swan for their attention.

There were **four (4) miscellaneous incidents** in the month of April 2023.


On 8 May 23, Security Officer found some bushes scattered on the middle of the road. Security Officer cleared the road for traffic. Picture below:

Major Security patrol vehicle is fitted with a GPS tracking system which enables us to track the location of our vehicle and gather other valuable data such as speed of the patrol car at any time of the day. Below is sample of the patrols we have carried out on the 8 April 2023. Details of the location of the vehicle can be obtained from the tracking system. Due to security reasons this GPS report will not be published to general public, however Major Security Service will provide a copy of the GPS reports upon City of Swan request.
