Community Security Patrols
March 2026



Overview

Major Security Services has been engaged to provide 24-hour, seven-day Community Security Patrol services for properties located within The Vines. Patrols are conducted throughout all streets within the suburb to maintain a visible security presence and assist in promoting community safety.

While patrols follow a structured coverage of the area, they are also undertaken at random and varied intervals to ensure patrol patterns remain unpredictable for security purposes.

Residents can contact the Community Security Patrol on **(08) 9278 9696** to report matters such as disorderly conduct, suspicious behaviour, loitering, burglary, anti-social behaviour, graffiti, maintenance hazards, or potential breaches of local laws.

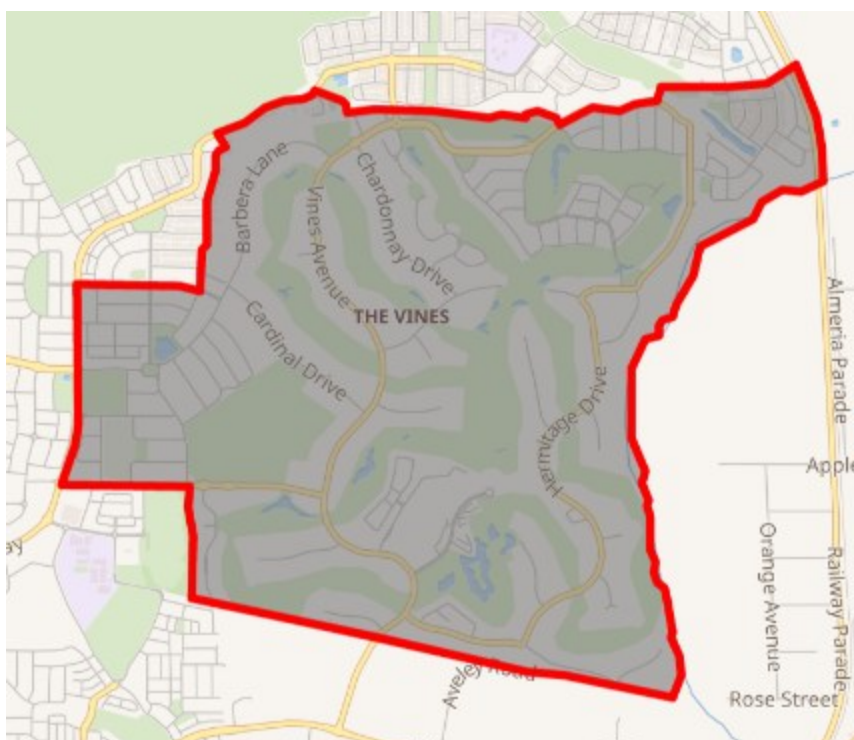

Community Engagement and Response Times

During March 2026, Major Security patrol officers recorded **358 interactions** with residents within The Vines community. Of these, **five (5)** interactions were direct responses to requests for assistance from residents.

Suspicious Activities

Surveillance Patrols

Patrol Monitoring and GPS Tracking

Major Security patrol vehicles are equipped with GPS tracking systems, which allow us to monitor the real-time location of patrol vehicles and capture operational data such as vehicle movement and speed at any given time.

The GPS system enables Major Security to verify patrol coverage throughout The Vines and ensures accountability in the delivery of the Community Security Patrol service.

Below is a sample overview of patrol activity conducted on 3 March 2026. Detailed location data of the patrol vehicle is recorded within the tracking system.

For security and operational reasons, the full GPS tracking reports are not published publicly. However, Major Security will provide copies of the GPS patrol reports to the City of Swan upon request.



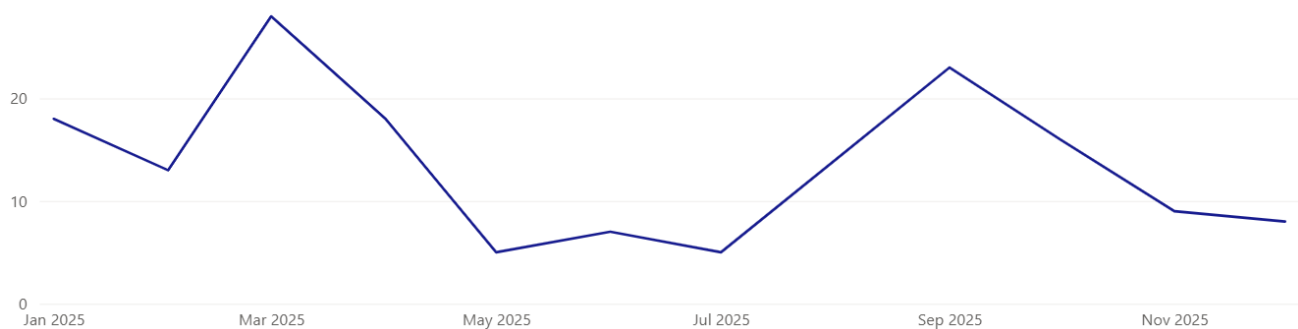
Crime Statistics
