To address the immediate and basic needs of injured wildlife

COVER

Cover bird/small animal with a towel or piece of clothing.

CONTAIN

Contain the animal to prevent further injury, eg. in a cardboard box.

CONTACT

Contact the nearest wildlife centre as listed here

- Never let an animal loose in the car.
- Keep in a warm, quiet, dark place.
- Give no food or water.
- Seek urgent help from a qualified person, either a vet or wildlife carer.
