



## Agenda Forums

### What is an Agenda Forum?

Agenda Forums are for agenda items which are to be considered by Council at the next ordinary meeting of Council.

They involve Councillors, relevant staff and, where appropriate, external consultants. Deputations and questions by the public on agenda items are heard at Agenda Forums.

Agenda Forums are not a decision making forum. They provide an opportunity for Councillors to be equally informed and seek additional information on matters prior to the presentation of such matters to the next ordinary meeting of Council for formal consideration and decision.

Agenda Forums will be open to the public except for matters of a confidential nature as defined by the *Local Government Act 1995*.

### Where and when are Agenda Forums conducted?

**Date:** On the Wednesday prior to each ordinary meeting of Council.

**Venue:** Council Chambers, Midland Town Hall, 312 Great Eastern Highway, Midland.
