Executive Summary, The Vines Community Patrols

This report provides details of the security patrols and incidents attended during the month of September.

The Braven Community Safety Patrol staff continue to build their profile and contact within The Vines community. Braven staff have been supplied with business cards for residents giving contact details for the patrols.

As the patrol profile has risen we are getting more calls and contact with residents.

Braven staff continue to liaise with the residents, Police, City of Swan staff and other stakeholders in the community to build the profile and assist residents wherever possible.

Below is a snapshot of incidents attended by Braven staff.

- **Vacant Premises.**

When residents have left their homes for extended periods on holidays etc they have been encouraged to advise our patrol staff who will conduct up to six checks a day on each of the premises during the normal patrols. Braven staff will contact residents on their return to ensure there were no issues at the property in their absence. **809** checks were conducted in September.

Note that these checks have not been included in the statistics as per previous months.

- **Graffiti**

Five Graffiti incidents were detected and reported to the City of Swan via the assistance line. Photographs of the graffiti is shown below.

- **Animal Interaction.**

4 Incidents of large animals being found deceased on side of road after being struck by motor vehicles. City of Swan advised in each instance and animals removed.

- **Suspicious Activity.**

1. On 8th September patrol staff noticed a group of youths in 7 vehicles parked in the carpark off Banrock Drive. Patrol kept an eye on the group during the evening and they left without incident.
2. On 8th September patrol staff noticed a vehicle parked suspiciously in Chardonnay Park. As the patrol staff approached the vehicle it was observed a pipe was running from the exhaust into the rear window of the car. The driver of the car then abused the patrol staff and drove off at high speed. The matter was reported immediately to Police and a look out kept for the vehicle whilst on patrol.
3. Patrols commenced in the vicinity of Sandy Lane after reports of youths congregating and possible drug use.

- **Vehicle issues.**

1. On 17th September a residents vehicle in Coton Square was observed to still have its lights on. Resident advised and turned the lights off.
2. On 21st September a report was received about an unlicensed motorcycle being ridden on the Golf Course near Crescendo Green. Patrols of the area did not identify any activity.
3. On the 26th September two vehicles at a work site in Hermitage Drive were observed to be parked dangerously giving limited room for residents to drive past. The vehicles were moved to a safer location at the request of the patrol officer.

- **Miscellaneous**

1. 3rd September, fencing around Chardonnay Park blown over by high winds. Developer to arrange fencing to be repaired via City of Swan.
2. 21st September, report received of noisy party in Tokay Lane. The resident was informed of the complaint and stated it was her sons birthday and a DJ was performing with music to be off by 11.00 PM.
